

Regathering Policies and Procedures



Check In:

RSVP

- Parents can RSVP their kids online via the church website
- Sign ups go live the Monday before service happens and are accessible until service starts
- Check in team members verify RSVP with the confirmation email and check in the appropriate kids
- This system gives parents flexibility to choose to stay home if the room is full
- Health screening happens as a part of RSVP and also as families arrive to campus

Temperature Checks/Health Considerations

- We will check everyone's temperature before they walk into the building and check in area (must be below 100.4)
- Kids and team members must wear masks (3yrs and up)
- Health screening confirmation at check in by team members: "How are you feeling? Has anyone in your household experienced any symptoms of illness this week?"
- Well-child policy extended to household: We are asking kids to stay home and participate in ONE&ALL Kids online via our Youtube channel if anyone in their household is not feeling well
- Hand sanitizer available to everyone who walks in, with the option to wash their hands instead. Encouraged but not required
- We will have extra masks available (both kids and adult sizes)

Maximum Room Capacities (with 2 adult team members in the room)

- 50% of our normal capacity

Early Childhood

- Teal (0-1): 4
- Purple (walkers): 6
- Blue (2s): 8
- Green (3-4s): 12
- Yellow (4-5s): 12
- Orange (Kindergarten): 12

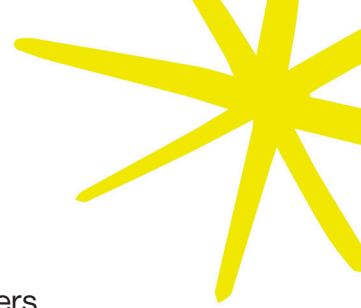
Elementary:

- Regular rooms: 12
- Large rooms: 16

Other Check In Policies

- One parent drop off and pick up to limit the amount of people in our kid spaces
- Only team members touch check in kiosks/screens
- Full policies and procedures document (this document) available if parents have questions
- Signage at entry communicating key safety policies and check in process details
- Waves, smiles, and air hugs are good; please avoid high fives, hugs, etc.

Programming:



Where do kids worship?

- Rooms only, no moving to other rooms or mingling with other groups of kids
- Large group moved to rooms, curriculum controlled from within the room by the leaders

What do kids do while they're here?

- Online kids service with message, game, and worship (same as YouTube service for the week)
- Community groups and activities
- Play time before and after
- Early Childhood: Craft and snack with prepackaged snacks
- Early Childhood: Playground used by one room at a time and cleaned after, also cleaned between services
- Water in disposable cups

How are kids checked out?

- One parent drop off and pick up to limit the amount of people in our kid spaces
- One entrance and one exit to keep traffic flow
- All kids need to be picked up immediately after adult service is over so we can clean and sanitize rooms between services
- Name tags must be removed from kids as they are checked out

Other Policies and Procedures:

- Bring your own Bible, no loaning/sharing Bibles at this time
- Please leave toys and personal items at home
- Toys are washed/sanitized between weekends
- Each service has a separate bin of toys that gets rotated out between services
- We are only using toys that are able to be thoroughly cleaned
- Sanitizable craft supplies: markers, twistable crayons, and glue (cleaned between services)
- All rooms and check in areas will be sanitized between services with the same sanitizer spray used for our adult worship spaces
- In the event of a COVID case in one of the households that checked in kids, we will notify the parents of all kids who were checked in to that room and will close the room for the following 2 weekends
- By submitting your RSVP, you agree to contact the ONE&ALL Kids staff if anyone in your household tests positive for COVID-19 after attending on campus services. Contact us by emailing kids@oneandall.church
- Changing pads are plastic and wiped down and/or single use paper covers
- No diaper bags: only one diaper, wipes, and bottle in a ziploc bag
