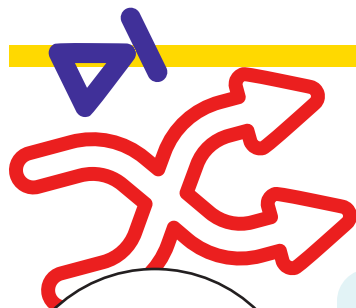


# Press Play: Get in the Mix

God can help us live with confidence.

## Activity

### Wash Away

#### What You Need:

Washable marker, soap, water, Bible

#### What You Do:

Read Romans 8:38-39 out loud.

Say, "NOTHING can make God stop loving us. But sometimes, when we mess up, it can make us feel like God won't love us anymore.

"I want you to take this marker and write on the back of your hand. Write down something you feel like could separate you from God's love. Maybe it's something you did a long time ago. Or something you did today! Just a couple of words to represent that thing."

Give your child a few moments to think and write. Help them with spelling, if they need it. Or give them privacy if they seem like they don't want you to see what they wrote. Once they're finished, say, "Now I want you to wash your hand with soap and water. Scrub, scrub, scrub until you can't see what you wrote anymore."

As your child washes their hands, make sure they get all the marker off. Then say, "Just like you can't see what you wrote anymore, when God looks at you, He doesn't see any of your mess-ups. He sees the awesome kid He made and loves. NOTHING can separate you from His love!"

## Talk About the Bible Story

Paul wrote these verses as part of a letter to the Romans. How do you think the Romans felt when they first read Paul's words? Why?

What makes you sure that God will always love you?  
(Knowing that He sent Jesus for you, reading verses like these in the Bible)

When you feel separated from God, what could help you feel close to Him? (Praying, reading the Bible, talking about Him, listening to worship music, walking in nature, creating art, etc.)

Parent: Share about a time when you felt far away from God's love. What did you do? How did you overcome how you felt and believe that God loves you no matter what?



## Prayer

Use this prayer as a guide, either after talking about the Bible story or sometime before bed tonight:

"God, thank You for loving us no matter what. You love each of us so much that You sent Jesus to rescue us! We are thankful that absolutely nothing can separate us from Your love. Help us grow in our relationship with You every day. Help us see ourselves the way You see us, so we can have the confidence to live our lives the way You want us to. We love You, and we pray these things in Jesus' name. Amen."

## Activity

### Emoji-tions

#### What You Need:

Phone, tablet, or other device with  
an emoji keyboard; and a Bible (or  
Bible app)

#### What You Do:

Give your child a device that has an  
emoji keyboard, and have them open  
the notes app (or another app they can  
type in).

Say, "Look through the emojis, and type  
at least 10 of them that represent the  
emotions you've felt over the last week."

Give your child time to type 10 (or  
more) emojis. Then choose three  
or four of them and ask your child  
to describe when they've felt those  
emotions.

Say, "You know what? We may feel a  
lot of different emotions on any given  
day. But no matter how we might feel,  
we can have confidence in knowing  
that God loves us. He loves us, He's  
for us, and He's with us. It's like Paul  
wrote in his letter to the Romans."

Read Romans 8:38-39 out loud.

Say, "Now, I want you to type three  
emojis that represent what it looks like  
to feel confident in God and His love."

Let your child type a few emojis that  
represent how God's love makes  
them feel.

## Talk About the Bible Story

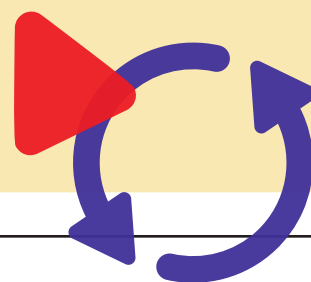
How has God shown you that He will never leave you?
