3. GOOD FRIEND BRAINSTORM

[LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: Butcher paper, marker, and wall tape

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Lay the butcher paper on the table. Encourage the children to gather around the table.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Ask for the children to answer the question, "What makes a good friend?" Write down their answers on the butcher paper.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: If possible, tape the butcher paper on the wall in your hallway for parents to see at pick-up.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, come to the table with me!"

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "Tell me, what makes a good friend? I will write your answers on the page. (If none of the following answers are given, add them to the paper.) That's right! A good friend is kind. A good friend uses nice words. A good friend hugs. A good friend shares."

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "I am SO thankful God gave us good, good friends! I can thank God for everything. Who can you thank for everything? I can thank God for everything."

6. JOURNAL AND PRAYER [PRAY TO GOD | PRAYER ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: Paperclip "Memory Verse Card" in your Bible at Psalm 111:1, journal, and a fun-shaped pen

BIBLE STORY

I can thank God for my friends.

DAVID AND JONATHAN 1 SAMUEL 18:1-4

MEMORY VERSE

"I will give thanks to the Lord with my whole heart."

PSALM 111:1, ESV

KEY QUESTION

Who can you thank for everything?

BOTTOM LINE

I can thank God for everything.

BASIC TRUTH

God loves me.

SGL: Now, let's sit down so we can write in our prayer journal and talk to God. (Hold journal and fun-shaped pen.)

"Jonathan was thankful for his friend, David, and David was thankful for his friend, Jonathan. Today, we'll make a list of friends we are thankful for. I want you to think of one friend you are thankful for. When I say your name, tell me your friend's name, and I will write it in our prayer journal. (Say each child's name and write down what they say. Remember to print the names so the children can recognize their names and the letters.)

"Look at all of your friends' names! Let's pray and thank God for each of them. Would anyone like to pray before I pray?"

(Give each child who wants to pray the opportunity to do so.)

PRAYER

SGL: "Dear God, Thank You for our friends. Thank You for [child's name] and their friend, [friend's name]. Thank You for . . . (continue to name each child and their friends). And thank You so, SO much that Jesus wants to be our friend forever. Please help us be a good friend by sharing, saying kind words, and helping others. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."
