3. Easter Cross Mosaic

WHAT YOU NEED: Pre cut Cross, crepe paper strips or confetti squares, glue sticks, permanent marker.

WHAT YOU DO:

- Give each kid cross cutout and a glue stick.
- Put several bowls or piles of confetti squares or crepe paper near each group of kids.
- Have the kids glue different colored papers to fill their cross as a mosaic.
- Explain that the cross is a symbol that reminds us that Jesus rose again on Easter Sunday.
- Allow time for kids to ask questions about the Gospel message and be ready to have conversations about what Jesus did.
- Remember that it is okay to not have all the answers! Go on the journey with them to find the answers to their questions in the Bible with them.
