SCRIPTURE:


- Matthew 25:35-40

GOAL OF COMMUNITY GROUPS:

During group discussion, students will be encouraged to share how they feel after hearing the students share and give them an opportunity to go deeper. Students can talk about serving and making a difference. God has uniquely gifted students to stand in the gap and serve those around them.

THINK ABOUT THIS:

When you were a student, what were the gaps that you stepped in and filled. Think of some of the things you did to stand in the gaps and pray about sharing them. If you cannot think of any gaps you filled as a student, then put yourself in your students shoes. Ask yourself how brave you would need to be and how you would need to prepare your heart to step into the gaps. Allow Jesus to speak to you as you lead your students in their community group time.



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This guide is a starting point, not an absolute. Adjust the questions and activities as needed, and don't feel like you need to do, or ask, everything you see here. The goal is to get students verbally engaging, NOT to get through everything in the curriculum.

DURING COMMUNITY GROUP

HIGH/LOWS & OPENING

Begin with highs & lows from their week after they introduce each other. Really take this time to listen and ask questions to show you are interested in their lives.
