Read: 1 John 3:16

Show Up

Jesus gave His life on the cross for us! The ultimate gift, that He gave to us! Thank Jesus for giving up His life for us!

DAY 1

Read John 15:5

Take a look at a tree outside. If you cut off the branches from that tree, would the leaves keep growing? Nope. To receive all the nutrients and water from the roots and soil that come up through the tree, the branches must be connected to the trunk.

Jesus is like the vine, and we are the branches. We cannot "bear fruit" without staying connected to Him. How do we do that? By reading His Word to discover how Jesus treated others! While He was on earth, Jesus never had any wealth, but He still was willing to give everything away, even His life. Jesus showed us how to be generous.

When we choose to give, we are following Jesus' example. Jesus gave everything He had, even His life, to make a way for you to have a relationship with God forever.


When you choose to be generous—to make someone's day by giving something away—you are copying how Jesus loved. When you give, you look most like Jesus!






