Read this prayer out loud:


"Dear Jesus, You are the light in the darkness. You were made to shine. Help me to learn to shine bright and to be a light to others around me.

Read Revelation 21:23



This week, each time you feel the sun on your face or gaze at the moon in the night sky, thank God for showing compassion toward you and ask for help to show compassion to others.










DAY 3


