## 3. THINGS THAT ARE RED, BLUE, YELLOW AND GREEN

[LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

**WHAT YOU NEED:** Red, blue, yellow, and green construction paper (one sheet of each) and a washable marker

### BIBLE STORY

On days three and four, God made the land, plants, sea, sun, moon, and stars.

**LAND, PLANTS, SEA & SUN, MOON, STARS**  
**GENESIS 1:9-19**

### MEMORY VERSE

"God saw everything he had made. And it was very good."

**GENESIS 1:31, NIRV**

### KEY QUESTION

Who made everything?

### BOTTOM LINE

God made everything.

### BASIC TRUTH

God made me.

#### WHAT YOU DO:

**BEFORE THE ACTIVITY:** Gather the children to sit in a circle in your activity area. Set out the four pieces of construction paper in front of you. Hold up each one to review the four colors.

**DURING THE ACTIVITY:** Pick up the red piece of construction paper and ask the children to name things God made that are red. If they are stumped, name some things from the list below. Write these items on the red construction paper in large block letters. Repeat with the blue, yellow, and green pieces of construction paper, writing the things the children name for each color.

**RED:** Apples, red birds, roses, lady bugs, strawberries, tomatoes

**BLUE:** Bluebirds, blueberries, whale, butterfly, sky

**YELLOW:** Sun, lemons, corn, bananas, bumble bees, star

**GREEN:** grass, green beans, limes, broccoli, frogs, leaves

#### WHAT YOU SAY:

**BEFORE THE ACTIVITY:** "Friends, have a seat with me. Let's make a big circle so everyone can see. Great job. Okay, tell me what colors you see." (Hold up each page and identify its color together.)

**DURING THE ACTIVITY:** "I want us to think of some things that God made that are red! (Hold up the red piece of paper.) I'll write our answers right on the red piece of paper. What about an apple? Apples are red!" (Continue with each color, helping with the answers above if needed.)

**AFTER THE ACTIVITY:** "You named SO many red, blue, yellow, and green things that God made! But He didn't stop there. God made brown, white, purple, and orange things! He made black and pink things, too. Because remember, **God made everything! Who made everything? God made everything!**"

## 6. JOURNAL AND PRAYER

[PRAY TO GOD | PRAYER ACTIVITY]

**WHAT YOU NEED:** Paperclipped "Memory Verse Card" in your Bible at Genesis 1:31; journal and a fun-shaped pen

### BIBLE STORY

On days three and four, God made the land, plants, sea, sun, moon, and stars.

**LAND, PLANTS, SEA  
& SUN, MOON, STARS  
GENESIS 1:9-19**

Now let's sit down so we can write in our prayer journal and talk to God. (*Hold journal and fun-shaped pen.*)

"Today, we'll make a list of our favorite things that grow in the ground. It can be a tree, like an apple tree. It can be a flower, like a sunflower. It can be a vegetable, like a carrot. It can be any kind of tree, plant, or flower—it can even be a berry bush! God made all kinds of trees and plants and flowers! (*Say each child's name as you write it down. Write down what they say beside their names. Remember to print so the children can recognize their names and the letters.*)

"This is such a great list of things God made. Let's use it when we pray. Would anyone like to pray before I pray?"

(*Give each child who wants to pray the opportunity to do so.*)

### MEMORY VERSE

"God saw everything he had made. And it was very good."

**GENESIS 1:31, NIRV**

### PRAYER

"Dear God, thank you for making the ground for things to grow in. Thank you for making the sun to help them grow. Some of our favorite things that grow in the ground are (*read the list the children made*). You are amazing, God, and we love you very much. In Jesus' name, amen."

### KEY QUESTION

Who made everything?

### BOTTOM LINE

God made everything.

### BASIC TRUTH

God made me.
